

# Minutes from Emery Town Council

## June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021

Members present: Amy Sundstrom, Pat Sundstrom, Mike Christensen, Sam Payne, and Alyscia Burr (Recorder)

**Meeting called to order at 7:10** US pledge of allegiance recited.

**Minutes from** May 2021 Town Council were reviewed. Sam made a motion to approve the minutes; Pat seconded. Amy: aye, Pat: aye, Mike: aye, Sam: aye.

**The Open Invoice report** was reviewed. Sam made a motion to approve payment all open/unpaid invoices; Pat seconded. Unanimous aye

**City Sanitation Renewal** Wade Williams brought the new contract renewal, it was reviewed and the council recommended looking into a County Sanitation. There will be an increase of 2% expected in January 2022. **Rates are based on the landfill prices.** Pat propose a bid to review options for fair pricing. A work meeting will determine the renewal on the 21<sup>st</sup>. If rates are higher with County Sanitation then the renewal for City Sanitation will be renewed. Pat motioned; Mike 2<sup>nd</sup>, Unanimous aye

**Mayor Amy Sundstrom** reported on the **COG Meeting**. Air B&B's the main discussion and are becoming more popular here in the county. The council decided to wait for more interest to make a decision.

**Council Member Mike Christensen** reported that he spoke with property owner Jared Parkinson regarding some **development** Mr. Parkinson was considering on his land. Mike relayed that upon learning the complexity and expense involved, it is unlikely that Mr. Parkinson will move forward with any of the projects at present.

**Council Member Pat Sundstrom** informed the Council that the CVSSD has raised concerns about the water situation as "Dire". Water conservation will soon have to be instated. New restrictions are being instated on **ONLY** watering 6 pm-10 am no daytime watering allowed without a fine and water shut off.

**Council Member Sam Payne** noted that he would like to review the enterprise and general budget from Emery Town's Annual budget Amendment. Mayor Amy Sundstrom briefly explained some of the Budgets inconsistencies and suggested a work meeting to amend the budget completely by the 22<sup>nd</sup> of June.

Pat made a motion to adjourn the meeting; Mike seconded it. Amy: aye Sam: aye.
